GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by our Proclamation dated the 29th day of January, 1996, we did dissolve the Forty Second General Assembly of Our Province of Newfoundland;

AND WHEREAS it is Our Will and Pleasure to summon and call a General Assembly within Our said Province and for that purpose to direct the issue of Writs of Election for a General Election of Members to serve in the House of Assembly of Our said Province;

AND WHEREAS under the authority of section 35 of the *Election Act* (the "Act"), We are empowered to direct the issuance of a Writ of Election for the election of Members to the House of Assembly;

NOW KNOW YE that We do by this Our Proclamation direct that a Writ of Election for each of the electoral Districts hereinafter mentioned be issued;

AND WE DO further direct

 That the date set to be the last day for the nomination of candidates for the Election in each Electoral District is Monday, the 12th day of February, 1996;

That the Writ of Election for each Electoral District shall be issued on Monday, the 29th day of January, 1996, and be returnable at the time and in the manner prescribed by section 82 of the Act, together with the return of the person to whom the writ is directed endorsed thereon, and all other documents and other things required to be transmitted to the Chief Electoral Officer by virtue thereof.
