Open Season Big Game (Polar Bear) Hunting Order, Labrador, 1996 under the Wild Life Regulations, 1984 and the Wild Life Act

(Filed February 27, 1996)

Under and by virtue of the powers conferred by sections 31 and 90 of the Wild Life Regulations, 1984, I make the following Order.

ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Open Season Big Game (Polar Bear) Hunting Order, Labrador, 1996.
- 2. The taking of polar bears is prohibited throughout Labrador except as provided for in this Order.
- 3. The open season for hunting polar bear in that portion of Labrador north of Cape Harrison shall be February 3, 1996 to June 29, 1996, both dates inclusive.
 - 4. Bag Limits

One polar bear of either sex except that female polar bears accompanied by cubs (young of the year) may not be taken.

- 5. Polar Bears shall only be taken by shooting.
- 6. Polar bears shall not be taken in a den and active dens shall not be disturbed in any way.
- 7. Polar bears equipped with radio transmitters and/or collars shall not be taken.
- 8. The Open Season Big Game (Polar Bear) Hunting Order, Labrador, 1995 (Newfoundland Regulation 11/95) is repealed.
