A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS pursuant to section 4 of the *Shops Closing Act*, chapter S-15 of the Revised Statutes of Newfoundland, 1990 (The "Act"), the days set for the observance of certain holidays are enumerated:

AND WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 4(6) of The Act, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may proclaim June 24, 1997 as the date to celebrate the public holiday of Discovery Day, 1997.

OF ALL WHICH Our Loving Subjects and all others whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
