Short title

1. This Order may be cited as the Health Care Institutions Community Services Order.

Assignment of services

- 2. A board or corporation constituted or continued under section 4 or 5 of the *Hospitals Act* and included in the Schedule is assigned the administration and delivery of the programs and services designated by the Minister of Health and Community Services under the
 - (a) Child Welfare Act;
 - (b) Adoption of Children Act;
 - (c) Day Care and Homemaker Services Act;

- (d) Neglected Adults Act;
- (e) Rehabilitation Act;
- (f) Young Persons Offences Act; and
- (g) Young Offenders Act (Canada).

Social workers

3. Where the Minister of Health and Community Services designates a program under an Act referred to in section 2, the powers and duties assigned to a social worker under that Act are conferred on a registered social worker employed by a board or corporation constituted or continued under section 4 or 5 of the *Hospitals Act* and included in the Schedule.
