Proclamation bringing the Act into force under the Urban and Rural Planning Act,2000 (O.C. 2000-500)

GREETING;

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 115 of the *Urban and Rural Planning Act*, 2000, Chapter U-8, SN 2000 (the "Act"), it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be Proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advise of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that the *Urban and Rural Planning Act, 2000*, Chapter U-8, Statutes of Newfoundland, 2000, shall come into force on January 01, 2001.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF WE have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.
