Proclamation re Writ of Election for the Districts of The Straits and White Bay North and St. Barbe under the

Elections Act, 1991, and House of Assembly Act

GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS under the authority of section 57 of the *Elections Act, 1991* (the "Act"), and pursuant to section 54 of the *House of Assembly Act*, upon the occurrence of vacancies by the resignation of sitting members in the district of The Straits and White Bay North on the 16th day of October 2000, and in the district of St. Barbe on the 2nd day of October 2000 we are directed to issue Writs of Election for the election of two Members to the House of Assmebly;

AND WHEREAS it is Our will and pleasure that Writs of Election be issued for the Election of Members to serve in the House of Assembly of our Province of Newfoundland for the Electoral Districts of The Straits and White Bay North and St. Barbe;

NOW KNOW YE that We do by this Our Proclamation direct that Writs of Election for the Electoral Districts of The Straits and White Bay North and St. Barbe be issued;

AND WE DO further direct

- That the date set to be the last day for nomination of candidates for the Elections is Saturday, the 20th day of January, 2001;
- 2. That the place for the nomination of candidates in The Straits and White Bay North is the Apostolic Building, Cloud Drive, in Roddickton;

- That the place for the nomination of candidates in St. Barbe is the Conference Room, Maynard's Torrent River Inn, in Hawkes Bay;
- 4. That the day of polling for the Election is Tuesday, the 30th day of January, 2001;
- 5. That the Writs of Election shall be issued on Monday, the 8th day of January, 2001 and be returnable at the time and in the manner prescribed by Division E of the Act, together with the return of the person to whom the Writs are directed endorsed thereon, and all other documents and other things required to be transmitted to the Chief Electoral Officer by virtue thereof.
