A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 30 of the Massage Therapy Act, S.N.L. 2001, cM-1.1, (the "Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the *Massage Therapy Act*, S.N.L. 2001, cM-1.1 shall come into force on June 1, 2002.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
