A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 2 of "An Act to Amend the Judgment Enforcement Act," SNL2006 c44, (the "Act"), it is provided that this Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that "An Act to Amend the Judgment Enforcement Act," SNL2006 c44 shall come into force on the date of publication in The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
