A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 27 of "*An Act to Amend the Securities Act No. 2*," SNL 2006 c42, (the "Act"), it is provided that this Act or one or more sections of this Act shall come into force on a date or dates to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the sections of this Act shall come into force on the dates set out below.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that

- 1) Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 10, 11, 12, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 23, 25 and 26 of "*An Act to Amend the Securities Act, No. 2*," SNL2006 c42 shall come into force on the date of publication of this proclamation in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*;
- 2) Sections 5, 7, 8, 9, 19, 22 and 24 of "*An Act to Amend the Securities Act, No. 2*," SNL2006 c42 shall come into force on September 1, 2007; and

3) Section 14 of "An Act to Amend the Securities Act, No. 2",
SNL2006 c42 shall come into force on May 1, 2008

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
