A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 36 of An Act Respecting Procurement by Public Bodies, Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador 2016, Chapter P-41.001 (the "Act"), it is provided that the Act, or a section, subsection, paragraph or subparagraph of the Act, comes into force on a day or days to be proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that section 31 of the Act shall now come into force:

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that section 31 of An Act Respecting Procurement by Public Bodies, Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador 2016, Chapter P-41.001 shall come into force on the date of publication of this proclamation in The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
