1. Section 22 of the *Milk Regulations, 1998* is repealed and the following substituted:

Minimum price for milk

- 22. The minimum price at which milk shall be bought, sold or offered for sale FOB registered**

processors premises in the province shall be \$139.76 per hectoliter of standard milk containing 3.6 kilograms of butterfat, and for every kilogram in excess of that butterfat content, the minimum price shall be adjusted by the amount of \$5.20 per hectoliter.

Commencement

2. These regulations come into force on May 1, 2024.
