A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 48 of An Act Respecting the Protection of Adults Act, Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador 2022 Chapter A-4.02 (the "Act"), it is provided that the Act come into force on a day to be proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall now come into force;

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that An Act to Amend the Financial Administration Act, Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador 2022 Chapter A-4.02, shall come into force on December 15th, 2022.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
