A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 10 of An Act Respecting Disclosure of Information under an Interpersonal Violence Disclosure Protocol, Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador 2019 Chapter I-18.1 (the "Act"), it is provided that the Act comes into force on a day to be proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall now come into force;

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that An Act Respecting Disclosure of Information under an Interpersonal Violence Disclosure Protocol, Statutes of
