GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by subsection (2) of Section 3 of The Judicature (Amendment) Act, 1972, it is provided that subsection (1) of Section 3 of the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that subsection (1) of Section 3 of the said Act shall come into force on the eighteenth day of July, 1972;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that subsection (1) of Section 3 of the said Act shall come into force on the eighteenth day of July, 1972:

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable E. John A. Harnum, Lieutenant-Governor in Our Province of Newfoundland.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 18th day of July, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two and in the Twenty-first year of Our Reign.
