GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 24 of The Newfoundland Public Service Commission Act, 1973, the Act No. 116 of 1973, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on the third day of September, 1974;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force on the third day of September, 1974;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

PUBLIC NOTICE

In the matter of the expropriation of land at Durrells Arm, in the Electoral District of Twillingate, in the Province of Newfoundland.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land situate and being at Durrells Arm, in the electoral district of Twillingate in the Province of Newfoundland, Canada, being bounded and abutted as follows: That is to say beginning at a point, said point having reference from the Northeast angle of land of Eli Reid as follows South six (6) degrees twelve (12) minutes West Seventy-two decimal three (72.3) feet, to the principal point of beginning; thence by land of Lloyd Earle South six (6) degrees twelve (12) minutes West Forty-seven decimal seven (47.7) feet, South seventy-three (73) degrees fourteen (14) minutes East One hundred and fifty decimal zero (150.0) feet, North six (6) degrees twelve (12) minutes East Forty-seven decimal seven (47.7) feet; thence by land claimed by the Estate of Dave Wheeler North sev-
