## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 42(1) of The Judicature (Amendment) Act, 1974, the Act No. 57 of 1974, it is provided that the said Act or any section or part thereof shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that Sections 27, 28, 29, 30 and 31 of the said Act shall come into force on Saturday, the Fifteenth day of May, 1976;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that Sections 27, 28, 29, 30 and 31 of the said Act shall come into force on Saturday, the Fifteenth day of May, 1976;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Gordon Arnaud Winter, Officer of Our Order of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor in and for Our Province of Newfoundland.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 7th day of May in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-six and in the twenty-fifth year of Our Reign.
