GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 7 of The Highway Traffic (Amendment No. 2) Act, 1975, the Act No. 74 of 1975, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on <u>Friday</u>, the Second day of January, 1976;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the vice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Procla-

mation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force on Friday, the Second day of January, 1976;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Gordon Arnaud Winter, Officer of Our Order of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor in and for Our Province of Newfoundland.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 24th day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and in the twenty-fourth year of Our Reign.
