A PROCLAMATION

on and from Monday, the 22nd. day of November, 1976, for such duration as is necessary for the hearing of such cases as the Court sees fit but not to exceed a period of two weeks from the said date.

AND of these presents, all Magistrates, the Sheriff, Officers of the Constabulary and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Bailiffs, Keepers of Gaols and other officers in the execution of their offices about the premises and all and singular other person whom these Presents do, shall or may concern, are hereby required to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.
