Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that
the whole of the said Act shall come into force on
Friday, the Ninth day of September, 1977;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the
advice of Our Executive Council of Our Pro-
vince of Newfoundland, do by this Our Procla-
mation declare and direct that the whole of the
said Act shall come into force on Friday, the
Ninth day of September, 1977;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS
AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may
concern are hereby required to take notice and
to govern themselves accordingly,

PUBLIC NOTICE

boundary of land claimed by Max Rowsell a dis-

imately E1,414,891 ft. and N18,030,205 ft.,
thence in a southeasterly direction a distance of
165 ft. to UTM grid station approximately
E1,414,992 ft. and N18,030,070 ft., thence in a
northeasterly direction a distance of 150 ft. to
UTM grid station approximately E,1,415,110 ft.
and N18,030,165 ft., thence in a northwesterly
direction of 180 ft. to the point of beginning, all
containing approximately 0.55 acres.
