#### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by Section 21(2) of *The Unified Family Court Act* it is provided that Section 21(1) of the said Act shall come into force on a day fixed by Proclamation;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that Section 21(1) of the said Act shall come into force on the date of publication of this Proclamation that is to say the 15th day of November, 1978;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that Section 21(1) of the said Act shall come into force on the date of publication of this Proclamation;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
