GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 13 of *The Municipal Grants Act*, Chapter 98 of 1977, it is
provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our
Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on
Tuesday, the first day of April, 1980;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our
Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said
Act shall come into force on Tuesday, the first day of April, 1980;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these
Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accord-
ingly.

and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.
