TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 3 of *The Accident and Sickness Insurance (Amendment) Act*, Chapter 59 of The Statutes of Newfoundland, 1978, it is provided that section 2 of the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that section 2 of the said Act shall come into force on Friday, the eleventh day of June, 1982;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that section 2 of the said Act shall come into force of Friday, the eleventh day of June, 1982;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.
