#### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 11 of *The Social Workers Registration Act*, Chapter 4 of 1979, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on Friday, the twenty-fourth day of August; 1979;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force on Friday, the twenty-fourth day of August, 1979;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

## **NEWFOUNDLAND REGULATION 139/79**

Blueberry (No. 2) Order, 1979 under the Blueberry Regulations, 1976 under

The Department of Forestry and Agriculture Act, 157

(Filed August 22nd, 1979)

Under and by virtue of the powers conferred by regulation 2(e) of the regulations relating to blueberries dated the 30th day of Juce, 1976, and published in the Newfoundland Gazette on the 9th day of July, 1976, and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, I hereby make the following Order.

#### ORDER

- I. This Order may be cited as the Blueberry (No. 2) Order, 1979.
- 2. No person shall pick blueberries by hand, rake or other mechanical means on Crown Land situated on the Island of Newfoundland with the exception of the Avalon Peninsula and Bonavista South Peninsula before the 25th day of August, 1979.
- 3. No person shall pick blueberries by hand, rake or other mechanical means on Crown Land situated on the Avalon Peninsula and Bonavista South Peninsula before the 1st day of September, 1979.
  - 4. The Blueberry (No. 1) Order, 1979 is hereby revoked.
