- 3. The open season for moose hunting shall be September 20 to November 14 in Areas A, B, C, D, E, F, and G and January 31, 1983 to March 26, 1983 for Areas I and J. There shall be no open season in Area H.
  - 4. The bag limit shall be one moose per licence.
  - 5. The licence quota shall be:

Management Area A - 5 either sex

Management Area B - 10 either sex

Management Area C - 7 either sex

Management Area D - 5 either sex

Management Area E - 6 either sex

Management Area F - 5 either sex

Management Area G - 5 either sex

Management Area H - NO OPEN SEASON

Management Area I  $\neq$  25 either sex

Management Area J/- 20 either sex

- 6. Licences shall be awarded by means of a draw.
- 7. Only "residents" as defined in THE WILD LIFE ACT may apply for moose licences.
- 8. The Open Season Big Game (Moose) Hunting Order, Labrador 1981, is hereby revoked.
