A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS We deem it expedient and necessary to appoint a Special Term or Session for the holding of a circuit of the Trial Division of Our Supreme Court on Circuit at the time and place hereinafter mentioned;

WE DO, THEREFORE, by this Our Proclamation declare to all Our Loving Subjects within Our Province of Newfoundland, that it is Our Will and Pleasure to direct and appoint that a Special Term or Session of the Trial Division of Our said Supreme Court on Circuit shall be open and holden at

GRAND BANK

on and from Tuesday, the 26th. day of June, 1984, for such duration as is necessary for the hearing of such cases as the Court sees fit;

AND of these presents, all Magistrates, the Sheriff, Officers of the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Bailiffs, Keepers of the Gaols and their officers in the execution of their offices about the premises and all and singular other persons whom these presents do, shall or may concern, are hereby required to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.
