GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 4 of *The Act to Amend The St. John's Assessment Act*, Chapter
71 of The Statutes of Newfoundland, 1983, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force
on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on Friday, the
13th day of July, 1984;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province
of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act shall come
into force on Friday, the 13th day of July, 1984;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may
concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly;

IN WITNESS WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great
Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

Member of Our Order of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor in and for the Pro-
