A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 21 of *The Psychologists Act*, Chapter 19 of The Statutes of New-
foundland, 1985, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Pro-
clamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on Friday, the
11th. day of July, 1986;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province
of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act shall come
into force on Friday, the 11th. day of July, 1986;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may
concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.
