

2. The Newfoundland Milk Marketing Scheme, as amended is further amended by adding thereto the following Sub-sections to Section 4:
  - “(20) The Commodity Board shall have the authority to administer The Newfoundland Milk Marketing Scheme, 1983, as amended from time to time.
  - “(21) The Commodity Board may determine from time to time in its absolute discretion the procedure for nomination of candidates and elections and by-elections for the offices of Member, Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Commodity Board as provided for in this Section.”
3. This Order shall come into effect on the day following its publication in The Newfoundland Gazette.
