GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 2 of *An Act to Amend The Embalmers and Funeral Directors Act, 1975*, Chapter 15 of The Statutes of Newfoundland, 1986, it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall come into force on Friday, the 10th. day of October, 1986;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the Act shall come into force on Friday, the 10th. day of October, 1986;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

NEWFOUNDLAND REGULATION 209/86

Order re: The Local Service District of Savage Cove  
under  
*The Municipalities Act*

(Filed October 10, 1986)

Under and by virtue of the powers granted to me by sections 629 and 632 of *The Municipalities Act* and all other powers enabling me, I make the following Order.

**ORDER**

1. Ordered that the area comprising the community of Savage Cove, in the Provincial Electoral District of Strait of Belle Isle, be established as a Local Service District by the name of "The Local Service District of Savage Cove".
2. Ordered that the boundaries for the said Local Service District shall be the area comprising the community commonly known as Savage Cove.
3. Ordered that a Local Service District Committee shall be elected to control and manage the affairs of the Local Service District in accordance with *The Municipalities Act* and Local Service District Regulations made thereunder.
