GREETING:

**A PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS in and by section 207 of *The Canada - Newfoundland Atlantic Accord Implemen-  
tation (Newfoundland) Act*, Chapter 37 of the Statutes of Newfoundland, 1986, it is provided that  
the Act or any provision thereof shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of  
Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall come into force on Saturday, the  
fourth day of April, 1987;

NOW KNOW YE that we, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province  
of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that *The Canada - Newfoundland  
Atlantic Accord Implementation (Newfoundland) Act* shall come into force on Saturday, the fourth  
day of April, 1987;

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OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Noel S. Goodridge,  
Chief Justice, Administrator, in and for Our Province of Newfoundland.

of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and  
eighty-seven and in the thirty-sixth year of Our Reign.
