GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 8 of *The Lotteries Act*, it is provided that the said Act shall come
into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the said Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province
of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that *The Lotteries Act*, shall
come into force on the date of publication of this our Proclamation in *The Newfoundland Gazette*.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may
concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
