A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, in and by section 8 of An Act to Amend the Election Act, the Jury Act, 1991, and the Elections Act, 1991, chapter 52 of the 1992 Statutes

of Newfoundland ("The Act"), it is provided that the Act or a section or subsection comes into force on a day or days to be proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

ST. JOHN'S, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 1994

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that sections 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of the said Act shall now come into force;

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of An Act to Amend the Election Act, the Jury Act, 1991, and the Elections Act, 1991, Chapter 52 of the Statutes of Newfoundland, 1992, shall come into force on the date of publication of this Our Proclamation in Our Newfoundland Gazette;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF WE have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.
