A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 36 of the *Act to Regulate the Electrical Power Resources of
Newfoundland and Labrador*, chapter E-5.1 of the Statutes of Newfoundland, 1994, it is provided that
the said Act or a part of section thereof shall come into force on a day to be proclaimed by the
Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act, with the exception of Part IV (sections
23 to 25) and section 29 shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1996;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act, with the exception of Part IV (section 23 to 25) and section 29, shall come into force on Monday, the 1st day of January, 1996;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly;
