GREETING;

A PROCLAMATION

,994

WHEREAS in and by section 73 of the *Pharmaceutical Association Act*, chapter P-12.1, Statutes of Newfoundland, 1994, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall come into force;

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that the *Pharmaceutical Association Act*, chapter P-12.1, Statutes of Newfoundland, 1994, shall come into force on the date of publication of this Our Proclamation in *Our Newfoundland Gazette*;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
