A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 10 of the "An Act to Amend the Judicature Act and the Unified Family Court Act", Chapter 43, SN 1997 (the "Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that "An Act to Amend the Judicature Act and the Unified Family Court Act", Chapter 43, Statutes of Newfoundland, 1997, shall come into force on the date of publication of this our Proclamation in the Newfoundland Gazette.
