A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 20 of the *Business Investment Corporation Act*, (the
"Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by
Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall now come into
force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advise of Our Executive Council
of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this Our Proclamation declare
and direct that the *Business Investment Corporation Act* shall come into force on April
1, 2002.
