A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 16 of the *Cruisehip Authority Act*, Chapter C-44, SN 1998 (the "Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that the *Cruiseship Authority Act*, Chapter C-44, Statutes of Newfoundland, 1998, shall come into force on the date of publication in *The Newfoundland Gazette*.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
