GREETING;

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 47 of the *Environmental Assessment Act, 2000*, SN 2000, c.E-14.1 (the "Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that the *Environmental Assessment*

Act, 2000, SN 2000, c.E-14.1, shall come into force on the date of publication in The Newfoundland Gazette.
