A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 34 of the *Child and Youth Advocate Act*, S.N.L. 2001, cC-12.01 (the "Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT We, by and with the advise of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the *Child and Youth Advocate Act*, S.N.L. 2001, cC-12.01 shall come into force on May 13, 2002.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
