A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 52 of "An Act to Revise the Law About the Practice of Optometry", SNE2004 cO-7.01, (the "Act") it is provided that this Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant Governor in council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that "An Act to Revise the Law About the Practice of Optometry", SNL2004 cO-7.01, shall come into force on the date of publication in The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
