A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 5 of "An Act to Amend the Victims of Crime Services Act, SNL2005, c24, (the "Act") it is provided that this Act shall come into force on a date to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall come into force on the date set out below.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that "An Act to Amend the Victims of Crime Services Act., SNL2005 c24 shall come into force on April 1, 2006.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
