Proclamation bringing the Act into force (SNL2005 cS-16.2) (July 1/05) under the Smoke-free Environment Act, 2005 (O.C. 2005-389)

GREETING;

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 15 of "An Act to Revise the Law Respecting Smoking in Public Places and the Workplace"; SNL 2005 cS-16.2, (the "Act") it is provided that this Act shall come into force on a day at an hour to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant Governor in council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall come into force on the date set out below.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that "An Act to Revise the Law Respecting Smoking in Public Places and the Workplace", SNL2005 cS-16.2, shall come into force on July 01, 2005.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
