1. The Convention between Canada and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland Providing for the Reciprocal Recognition and Enforcement of Judgments in Civil and Commercial Matters came into force in the Province of Newfoundland on August 1, 1991; and
2. Applications for the registration of a judgment given by a court of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland may be made in the Supreme Court of Newfoundland, Trial Division.
