BACKGROUND

Due to the large number of Directives approved by the Management Commission since 2007, the House of Assembly conducted a review of all Directives to determine those that could be incorporated directly into the *Members' Resources and Allowances Rules* (the Rules). After completing this review, it was determined that some Directives had become redundant due to the approval or amendment of policies and guidelines by the Commission.

Directive **2007-006** was issued following the August 29, 2007 meeting of the Management Commission to address certain omissions and deficiencies in the *Members' Resources and Allowances Rules* (the Rules) respecting acceptable advertising expenses. At its May 13, 2009 meeting, the Commission approved the Advertising Policy for Members of the House of Assembly (Directive 2009-004 refers), making Directive 2007-006 redundant.

Directive **2007-010** was issued following the November 28, 2007 meeting of the Management Commission to address omissions and deficiencies regarding the Standard Office Allocation Package for Members. At its May 26, 2010 meeting, the Commission updated the Standard Office Allocation Package for Members of the House of Assembly (**Directive 2010-011 refers**), making Directive 2007-010 redundant.

DIRECTIVE

The Commission rescinded Directives 2007-006 and 2007-010.
