INTRASESSIONAL PROCEEDING

At 9:15 a.m., the Honourable the Speaker (D. Bennett) and the Clerk of the House of Assembly appeared before the Honourable Joan Marie J. Aylward, O.N.L, B.N., R.N., ICD.D., Lieutenant Governor of Newfoundland and Labrador, at Government House.

The Speaker addressed the Lieutenant Governor as follows:

"It is my agreeable duty on behalf of His Majesty's dutiful and loyal subjects, His Faithful Commons in Newfoundland and Labrador, to present to your Honour bills for the appropriation of supply granted in the present session."

The Clerk read the following bills:

A bill, "An Act for Granting to His Majesty Certain Sums of Money for Defraying Certain Expenses of the Public Service for the Financial Year Ending March 31, 2025 and for Other Purposes Relating to the Public Service" (Bill 72);
and

A bill, "An Act to Authorize the Raising of Money by Way of Loan by the Province" (Bill 73).

The Lieutenant Governor then said, "In His Majesty's Name, I thank His Loyal Subjects, I accept their benevolence, and I assent to these bills."

The Speaker further addressed Her Honour as follows:

"May it please Your Honour, the General Assembly of the Province has at its present Session passed a bill, to which, in the name and on behalf of the General Assembly, I respectfully request Your Honour's assent."

A bill, “An Act to Amend the Tourist Accommodations Act” (Bill 75).
