ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Road Order (No. 2), 1971.

2. The following highways are hereby designated as Protected Roads for the purpose of controlling development:

(a) The Bonavista Highway (Route 10) both existing and proposed from the northern boundary of the Town of Clarenville to the junction of Route 10 and Route 24 at Southern Bay.

(b) The Bonavista Highway (Route 24) both existing and proposed from the junction of Route 10 and Route 24 at Southern Bay to the southern boundary of the Town of Port Union.

(c) The Bonavista Highway (Route 24) between the northwestern boundary of the Town of Little Catalina and the southern boundary of the Town of Bonavista.

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that Section 4 of the said Act shall come into force on Tuesday, the Fourteenth day of December, 1971;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
