GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 33 of The Collection Agencies Act, 1973, the Act No. 14 of 1973, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on the first day of April, 1974;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force on the first day of April 1974;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

In the matter of the expropriation of land at Manuels, in the Electoral District of Harbour Main, in the Province of Newfoundland.

TO:

All persons and corporations having or claiming any estate or interest in the land hereinafter described.

TAKE NOTICE that the said land has been expropriated by Notice of Expropriation dated the 4th. day of March, A.D., 1974 in accordance with The Expropriation Act, Chapter 121 of The Revised Statutes of Newfoundland, 1970. The said land being more particularly described as follows: ALL THAT piece or parcel of land situate at Manuels, Electoral District of Harbour Main, Province of Newfoundland, bounded and

abutted as follows, that is to say, beginning at the point of intersection of the boundary line between the property of Reverend Canon Colley on the east and the property of Rideout's Farm on the west with the southe boundary of the proposed new highway "Trans Canada Highway to Manuels", said point being distant one hundred fifty (150') feet measured at right angles south westerly from the center line of the said highway, proceeding thence north seventy degrees west one thousand one hundred ninety (1190') feet more or less; thence in a north westerly direction along the north easterly boundary of Fowlers Lane for a distance of two hundred thirty (230') feet more or less; thence north eighty nine degrees east five hundred five (505') feet more or less; thence south seventy degrees east eight hundred (800') feet more or less; thence due south three hundred thirty (330') feet more or less to the point of commencement containing in all seven point nine four (7.94) acres more or less. All bearings herein are referred to the True Meridian. AND ALSO ALL THAT piece or parcel of land situate at Manuels, Electoral District of Harbour Main, Province of Newfoundland, bounded and abutted as follows, that is to say, beginning at the point of intersection of the south westerly boundary of the property of Rideout's Farm with the southerly boundary of the proposed new highway "Trans Canada Highway to Manuels", said point being distant one hundred fifty (150') feet measured at right angles south westerly from the center line of the said highway proceeding thence north thirty degrees thirty minutes west one hundred fifty five (155') feet more or less; thence north eighty nine degrees east twenty eight point six (28.6') feet more or less; thence south thirty eight degrees thirty minutes east one hundred sixty (160') feet more or less; thence south thirty degrees thirty minutes east forty (40') feet more or less; thence north seventy degrees west eighty (80') feet more or less to the point of commencement containing in all zero point one six (0.16) acres more or less.
