A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 19 of The Ter-
mination of Employment Act, 1973, the Act No.
19 of 1973, it is provided that the said Act shall
come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclama-
tion of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that
the said Act shall come into force on Wednesday,
the Fifth day of May, 1976;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the
advice of Our Executive Council of Our Pro-
vince of Newfoundland, do by this Our Procla-

mation declare and direct that the said Act shall
come into force on Wednesday, the Fifth day of
May, 1976;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS
AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may
concern are hereby required to take notice and
to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have
caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and
the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto
affixed.

for Our Province of Newfoundland.

Our City of St. John's this 4th day of
May in the year of Our Lord one
thousand nine hundred and seventy-
six and in the twenty-fifth year of Our
Reign.
