#### NOTICE OF APPROVAL CORNER BROOK MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENTS, 1973.

I, Harold A. Collins, Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, under and by the powers conferred by The Urban and Rural Planning Act, 1965, hereby approve the Corner Brook Municipal Plan Amendments, 1973, adopted by the City of Corner Brook on the 11th. day of December, 1972, subject to the following exceptions and qualifications:

- (a) Amendment #2 proposing the rezoning of land bounded by the Ball Diversion, Country Road, and the rear boundaries of residential lots fronting Glen Haven Blvd. and Country Road from "Residential" to "Local Commercial" shall not be approved.
- (b) Amendment #5 (a) proposing the rezoning of approximately three and one-half acres of land belonging to the Blomidon Golf and Country Club between Lady Bowater Park and the Recreational Open Space Zone (Golf Course) from "Open Space" to "Residential" shall not be approved.
- (c) A portion of the Salvation Army property located on Pioneer Street Extension, as delineated on Annex A, shall be rezoned from "Community Service Area" to "Residential".

The said Amendments shall be read together with and shall form part of the Corner Brook Municipal Plan to which they relate.
