A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Sub-section (3) of Section 15 of The Workmen's Compensation (Amendment) Act, 1973, the Act No. 115 of 1973, it is provided that Sections 2, 3, 4, 11 and 12 of the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Sections shall come into force on the third day of July, 1973;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that Sections 2, 3, 4, 11 and 12 of the said Act shall come into force on the third day of July, 1973.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these

Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
